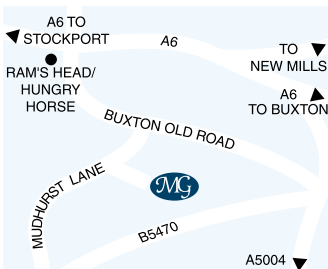

Directions

Exit the M60 at Junction 1. follow signs for A6 Buxton. Stay on the A6 for approximately 8 miles. You will then pass Lyme Park National Trust House and enter the village of Disley. At the traffic lights (With the Rams Head Pub on the right) turn right onto Buxton Old Road. Continue up the hill for about 1 mile over the speed bumps. Take the next turning on the right hand side, onto Mudhurst Lane, with the stone barn on the corner. The hotel is just a mile along the road on the left hand side.
